Class 1 Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 40cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

Class 2 Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 50cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

Class 3 Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 60cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

Class 4 Grass Roots Qualifier Individual – Fences 70cm.
Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

Class 5 Mini Team & Individual (RPL) – Fences 70cm.
Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

Class 6 Novice Team & Individual (RPL) - Fences 80cm.
Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

Class 7 Intermediate Teams & Individual (RPL) - Fences 90cm.
Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

Entry fees: Pre-entries only £10 individual, team £40. First aid cover £4 per rider. No entries on the day.

Prizes: Rosettes to 6th place.
