Class 21: Warm Up Prelim 7 (2002 (revised 2016))

Class 22: Team & Individual County Qualifier

Test : **Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)** – for all riders

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders also automatically count for individual placings

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse & rider combinations with 21 BD points or less, gained together at novice level. Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 23: Warm Up Novice 30 (2006)

Class 24: Novice 27 (2007) – individual county qualifier only
The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for the NSEA RPL Points League

Class 31A Walk & Trot Introductory A (2008)(may be led / assisted)

Class 32A Prelim 2 (2016).....(may be led / assisted)

Class 32B Prelim 2 (2016)(may not be assisted)

Class 33 Prelim 7 (2002)(may not be assisted)

All tests may be called (Classes 1 – 5)

In led / assisted classes an assistant may run alongside the pony however they must not attempt to affect the outline of the pony and the rider should be steering.
