Class 1 Warm Up

Prelim 1 (2006) / Novice 28 (2008) % Class – you may ride any or both test in this Class. Highest % wins (if you ride 2 tests you pay the entry fee twice).

Class 2 Team & Individual County Qualifier

Test : Prelim 14 (2006) (revised collective marks 2016) – for all riders

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders also automatically count for individual placings

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse & rider combinations with 21 BD points or less, gained together at novice level. Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 3 Novice 27 (2007) – individual county qualifier only.

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points

Prizes: Individual rosettes 1st – 6th place in each class.

Winter Eventers Challenge 2018-19

The course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks.

Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 325- 375m/m. Jumping penalties have priority over time faults – so unlike Arena Eventing (JWS) ideally, you need to go clear to win!

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee for classes 1 -4 = **£21** per rider per round. Late entries £3 extra if space permits.
Fee includes First Aid cover.

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Compulsory Retirement
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 325-375 metres / minute. No stopwatches allowed.	

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats, no fixed peak SJ hats.

In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.
