Class 1 Warm Up Prelim 2 (2016)

Class 2 Team & Individual County Qualifier

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) – for all riders

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders also automatically count for individual placings

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse & rider combinations with 21 BD points or less, gained together at novice level. Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 3 **Novice 27 (2007)** – individual county qualifier only.

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points

Entry Fee: Warm up Class £12 per test. Qualifying Classes £16 per test. Cheques payable to Kings Equestrian. Entries may be made on the official entry form or on line at www.kingsequestrian.co.uk. Only entries with the correct payment and current NSEA number will be accepted.

ROSETTES 1st - 6th Prize/Trophy to all Winners of classes 2 & 3
