## Rules – NSEA ‘Additional Rules for Qualifiers 2019’

**Entry Fee** - £20 per test, £75 **team** of 4. (Includes NSEA levy and First Aid fee) Late entries Add £2 per test

Teams made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count.

All team rider's scores will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA ‘Additional rules’).

It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to ensure eligibility of all their team entries.
