Individual 1.10m qualifiers for horses and ponies (separate sections)
Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section. One round, single phase.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual National Qualifier and Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals at Bury Farm April 2019. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual National Qualifier and Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals at Bury Farm April 2019. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Also qualifier for the **Windsor Team Qualifier 90/95 cm on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2019**The highest placed 2 teams will qualify for Windsor NSEA SJ Championship 2019. The top two teams must be from different schools

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual National Qualifier and Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals at Bury Farm April 2019. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Also qualifier for the **Hickstead Elite 1m Team Qualifier.** The top 2 teams will qualify to compete at Hickstead (1<sup>st</sup> August 2019). Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. One round, single phase.

Class 5a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual National Qualifier and Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals at Bury Farm April 2019. Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

Also qualifier for the **Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Qualifier. The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead (1<sup>st</sup> August 2019). Individual 1.10m qualifiers for horses and ponies (separate sections). Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section. One round single phase**
