Class 1 Prelim 1 (2006) Warm up class Entry fee £15

Class 2 Team & Individual County Qualifier

Test: Prelim 14 (2006) – for all riders Entry fee £15

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. All team riders also automatically count for individual placings.

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse/rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse/rider with 21 BD points or less, gained at novice level. Horse/rider combinations may compete at BD bronze and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 3 Individual County Qualifier

Test: Novice 27 (2007) – for all riders Entry fee £15

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to riders not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level and horses with 49 BD points or less (gained at BD novice level or above).

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points.

Start times will be available on the NSEA website 2 days before the competition www.nsea.org.uk

The highest placed team & individual from Surrey, West Sussex and London schools will represent their county at the NSEA National County Championships in April 2019. If they are unable to go, or have already qualified, the qualification will be passed down the line on the day.

Rules

No refunds after close of entries.

No horse or pony under 4 years of age may enter.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.

In the event of adverse weather conditions, it is the competitor's responsibility to seek confirmation as to the cancellation of any event.

A rider may only compete once in any team, therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team. No horse may be ridden by two different riders in the same class.

Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary by the Team Manager only, within 20 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £30, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

Your Responsibility

Whilst all reasonable steps have been taken to ensure the health & safety of persons present at the event, Oldencraig accept no liability for any accident, loss or damage (save for death or personal injury) to any person, animal or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or otherwise.
