## Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count

For *County Championships*, all 4 riders ride test P14, Class 1.

For *National Championships* - Up to two riders to compete in Class 2 test Prelim 13 and up to two riders in Class 3 the Novice 28 test.

Class 4 Elementary 50 is for individual riders for the National Championships only.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules')

**Class 1 – County Championships Qualifier** - All team members ride test P14. The winning team and individual from each County will qualify for the County Championships at Hartpury in April 2020. Points will also count towards the RPL.

**Classes 2,3 and 4 – National Championships Qualifier** - In each team up to 2 members will ride test P13, and up to two members will ride test N28.

The top 2 teams, and 4 individuals in each class, will qualify for the National Championships at Addington in October 2020.

Teams placed 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> in classes 1 and 2, and Individuals placed 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> in classes 2,3 and 4 will qualify for the NSEA Champions Plate 2020 at Keyso

## Rules – Please read NSEA General Rules, plus 'Additional Rules for Qualifiers 2020'

Please note that whilst dressage tests at Qualifying competitions may be called, and riders may carry a whip, at the Championships tests must be ridden from memory, and whips may not be carried.

Dressage tests at the Championships will be in a long arena.
