

Class 1 60 – 65cm Warm Up (Not a qualifying Class) Open to all.

Single phase.

£15/entry

Class 2 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2022)

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

£18/entry

Class 3 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

£18/entry

Class 4 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

All team riders automatically count as individuals

£18/entry

Class 5 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals

£18/entry

Class 6ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier 6a) horses and 6b) ponies
