Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2021)
All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier a) horses and b) ponies
Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony section of the class, as the class will be split.

• All persons Must wear a riding hat/helmet to current UK Safety Standards with a 3 point harness whilst mounted at all times • The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary by the Team Manager only, within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £30, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld. • Please close the gate on entering and exiting KSEC at all times • Please take all your rubbish home • Please pick up your horse droppings and hay from the car park • Mucking out of trailers and lorries on site is forbidden • Dogs on leads at all times • No smoking or dogs allowed in arena • We reserve the right to run classes early (or late), • We hold a strictly controlled warm up at KSEC no more than 6 riders warming up at one time . • Only the KSEC Staff allowed on foot in the warmup and controlling the warm up jumps. • All schools must be members of the NSEA – see website for NSEA Insurance details. Hot and cold food and drinks will be available all day. Photographer in attendance. Event Paramedic services in attendance Please note Parents/carers/ managers – you are politely reminded to read remember the "Parents code of conduct". Any complaints need to be submitted to the official steward and the judges within 15 minutes of your objection along with a £30 nonrefundable deposit. Only refundable if the objection is upheld.
