Rules – NSEA General Rule plus ‘Additional Rules for Qualifiers 2020/21’

- CLASS 1** **60-65cm Warmup**
Open to all. No style mark. Winner closest to the Optimum Time.
Non Qualifier: Entry Fee £17
- CLASS 2** **Mini 70-75cm Team and Individual Qualifier**
Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2021
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- CLASS 3** **Novice 80-85cm Team and Individual Qualifier**
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- CLASS 4** **Intermediate 90-95cm Team and Individual Qualifier**
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- CLASS 5** **Open 1 -1.05m Team and Individual Qualifier**
All team riders automatically count as individuals
- CLASS 6** **Advanced 1.10m Individual qualifier a) horses and b) ponies**
Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony as this class will be split.
- Entry Fee**
Class One: £17 per entry
Class Two – Six : £23 per entry including paramedic Cover
