<u>Class W</u> - 60cm – open to all - Warm up class also Grass Roots Qualifier – Individual only – single phase

Class 1 - 70cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 2 - 80cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 3 - 90cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 4 - 1m RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

<u>Class 5ab</u> - 1.10m Individuals only Single phase. Class split into a: Ponies and b: Horses

Entry Fee £17 per class including Paramedic First Aid Cover

Classes 1-5 - NSEA 30cm Rule applies.

Class W – Grassroots rules apply only if rider is eligible for grassroots competition.
