Winter Eventers Challenge 2018-19

The course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks.

Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 325- 375m/m. Jumping penalties have priority over time faults – so unlike Arena Eventing (JwS) ideally, you need to go clear to win!

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier) Entry Fee - £16

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier) Entry Fee - £16

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier) Entry Fee - £16

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier) Entry Fee - £16

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee:£16

Paramedic First Aid Cover £5 per rider per day

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Compulsory Retirement
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 325-375 metres / minute. No stopwatches allowed.	

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats, no fixed peak SJ hats. In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

Team Managers please remember;

ONLY the Team Manager is to deal with the Secretary and/or officials of an event.

The Team Manager is responsible for the conduct of all riders, parents and persons associated with their School

The Team Manager is the school representative on the day. They need to ensure that they themselves, riders and parents from their school display good sportsmanship, horsemanship and equine welfare at all times and adhere to the NSEA rules.

Rudeness to other competitors, spectators and staff will not be tolerated. The Show Organiser retains at their absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry without being required to assign reason or being liable for any refund or compensation.

Your Responsibility - All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition

The competitions in this schedule will hereinafter be referred to as the Show. 2.The Show, Show Organiser, Volunteer and Officials do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. 3.The Show Organiser retains as it absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation. 4. Competitions - The Show Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions, as they think fit. 5. By entering a class you agree you are at a suitable and safe level of ability to compete in these competitions. 6. Smoking - Smoking is not permitted within any of the showground buildings or stables. 7. Collecting Ring - All warming up must be done in the designated collecting Rings provided. Persons found abusing horses on the showground may be asked to leave. 8. Refund of Entry will only be made before the closing date of the competition. NO REFUNDS will be issued after the closing date under any circumstances. 9. Cheques - Cheques should be made payable to 'Equivents UK Ltd'. Any cheques that are returned for any reason will incur the person entering a £30 charge. You are liable for this even if you subsequently withdraw.10. Vehicles – The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal. 11. Dogs - Dogs are permitted in the Lorry Park and car park only. They must be kept under control at all times. If, in the opinion of the Show Organiser, any person fails to control their dog/s they may be asked to leave the show ground. 12. Prize Givings - The Show Organiser reserves the right to withhold prizes if competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving without asking permission for your absence 13. Objections - Objections should be made in writing within 1hr of the incident taking place and be accompanied by a £50 deposit that will be returned if your objection is upheld. 14. Official Photographs – Any photographs taken at the show by the official photographer may be used by the Show Organiser for promotional purposes. Please indicate on your entry form if you do not wish to appear in photos used for promotional purposes. 15. First Aid - A total of £4 per competitor per day. 16. Vaccination Certificate - All horses at the show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of certificates and any horse found without a valid certificate will be asked to leave the show ground. 17. Stallions - No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she I responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury. 18. Close of Entries - Entries will close on the official closing date. Should space be available late entries may be accepted.
