Information for Team Managers & Parents

The NSEA are very grateful to Hickstead for allowing us to use this beautiful venue, especially as the Derby Meeting and Royal International are just around the corner. Please help us make this championships a successful and happy one for all.

Please read the following information and ensure all adhere to the information below:

Riders are the responsibility of Team Managers / Parents at all times. They may not stay on site overnight without an adult present. The **Team Manager** is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties (parents, supporters etc) at **all times** on the show ground. Parents – please keep all children & animals under control- (whether competing or not!)

After 10p.m, the stable & horsebox areas should be quiet. Please be aware that horses and their riders need to rest and therefore noise, lighting and intrusion should be kept to an absolute minimum. Late night checks should be conducted prior to 10p.m. please

LORRY PARK/STABLING

please go to entry.equilive.uk for online stabling booking

All horseboxes to park on the stable field. Stabling will be open from 10.30am on Saturday but no riding until 12 noon. WH Security are on site throughout the weekend. Please ensure you remain parked as requested on arrival.

All temporary STABLES need to be MUCKED OUT & the remaining clean bedding banked up on the sides, leaving the floor clean to dry. Please leave your stable as you would like to find it. Please use designated muck heaps.

If you are not staying on site overnight we advise you leave a contact number on your stable door.

BBQs are permitted but please ensure they are off the ground and made safe after use.

SATURDAY

Warm up classes will start 1 hour before Championship classes. (approx 1pm)

SUNDAY AND MONDAY

The secretary's office will be open at 7.30am and is situated in the Dick Sanders Pavilion near Ring 4, The Eventers Challenge Arena.

HORSES ARE ONLY TO USE THE WALKWAY TO YOUR DESIGNATED RINGS AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE DO NOT RIDE ON THE GRASS OR HACK AROUND THE TRACKS AT VENUE. THE INTERNATIONAL WARM UP ARENA WILL BE OPEN FOR EXERCISING EACH DAY (NO JUMPING IN THIS ARENA).

Nosebag Catering Van and the Polo Clubroom will be open from 8am.

Only 8-10 competitors are allowed in the jumping warm up areas at any one time.

IF SUPPORTERS ARE ARRIVING IN A CAR THEY CAN ACCESS THE MAIN SHOWGROUND AND PARK IN THE VIP CAR PARK AT THE BACK OF THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA. THIS IS CLEARLY SIGNPOSTED. THERE IS NO PARKING AT RING SIDES AND PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS.

THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA IS OUT OF BOUNDS THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE WEEKEND. IF ANYONE IS FOUND ON FOOT OR ON HORSEBACK IN THE ARENA THEY WILL BE ELIMINATED. IT IS CURRENTLY UNDERGOING PREPARATION WORK FOR THE FORTHCOMING INTERNATIONAL SHOWS.

Eventers Challenge Championships 2019

The course is made up of SJ & XC fences and will be run in the outdoor sand arena and will be made up of approx. 16-18 fences including steps, banks and a new water complex

Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time. NSEA / BE Eventing Rules for tack & rider equipment. There will be no style mark.

Saturday Approx. 1pm start. Sun/ Mon 9am start each day (but we may start earlier if entries are large)
Eventers Challenge National Championships Classes for pre-qualified teams & individuals only

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Crash hats & body protectors as per British Eventing Rules 2019 for XC, no fixed peak SJ hats.

In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

Class 1 Equine America Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Championships (350m/m)

Sunday

Class 2 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Championships (350m/m) (no age restriction)

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Championships (350m/m)

Monday

Class 4 Open 1-1.05m Team & Individual Championships (375m/m)

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee Classes 1 – 4 = £28 per rider per round

Paramedic First Aid Cover £4 per rider per day.

Horses should be entered under passport names but put stable name in brackets if that is the name it has been competing under.



Jumping penalties for Eventers Challenge are awarded as follows....

Knockdown (to include SJ and a few xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
1st Rider Fall	Elimination

Horse Fall	Elimination
Starting before the bell /Retaking an obstacle already jumped/ Error of course	Elimination
Every commenced second over or more than 15 seconds under the optimum time	1 penalty
Exceeding time limit (3 times the time allowed)	Elimination
Speed 350 – 375 metres / minute. No stopwatches allowed.	

Each team of four at the Championships must include two out of the original qualified four horse/rider combinations. However, if, in exceptional circumstances, a previously qualified team has only one of the original horse/rider combinations remaining, the School may be permitted, at the discretion of the NSEA, to substitute two new horse/rider combinations to make up a team of three

Other Classes (open to all)

Saturday - The International Polo Arena

(approx 1pm start)

Class 5 80cm Novice Challenge Class start at approx. 1pm Single phase. Entry Fee £18

Warm Up classes will include a mixture of SJ and XC style fences.

Class 6 Mixed Height Jumping. Entry Fee £18 per rider.

Teams of 3 or 4 horse & rider combinations, best 3 scores to count. This class will include a mixture of SJ and XC style fences. Single phase, to follow class 5. This class counts for team RPL points.

One rider per height per team to jump 7a) 70cm, 7b) 80cm, 7c) 90cm, 7d) 1m

Sunday - The International Polo Arena

Class 7 JwS Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual NSEA Championships Qualifier for Addington

All team riders automatically count as individuals. Entry Fee £22

Class 8 JwS Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual NSEA Championships Qualifier for Addington

All team riders automatically count as individuals. Entry Fee £22

Class 9 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual NSEA Championships Qualifier for Addington

All team riders automatically count as individuals. Entry Fee £22

Monday - The International Polo Arena -

Class 10) 1m Team Hickstead Elite Show Jumping Championships Qualifier. Entry Fee £18.

Qualification is for TEAMS only. However riders may compete as individuals.

Class 11) 1.10m Individual Hickstead Elite Championships Show Jumping Championships Qualifier. Entry Fee £18
a) Horses and 9b) Ponies

All jumping courses may be raised up to 5cm from the qualifiers, at the Championships.
