Class 1: **80 Training** Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Dressage BE 96 (2016), SJ and XC max height 80cm, XC optimum time 435m/min.

Entry Fee: £70.00 (inc vat + medical provision) + £10 Start Fee

Class 2: **90 Intro** Team & Individual Qualifier.

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Dressage BE 96 (2016), SJ and XC max height 90cm, XC optimum time 450m/min

Entry Fee: £70.00 (inc vat + medical provision) + £10 Start Fee

Class 3: **100 Open** Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Dressage BE 107 (2016), SJ and XC max height 100cm, XC optimum time 475m/min

Entry Fee: £70.00 (inc vat + medical provision) + £10 Start Fee

**Start Fee: Payable on the day (preferably in cash) at the Secretary's when declaring and collecting numbers.**

Individual rosettes 1st – 10th place in each class.

Top 4 teams & top 4 individuals per section to qualify for the 2019 Championship

Substitution- a qualified team may substitute up two 2 riders at the final but these riders must have competed in one of the 10 qualifying events or the BE equivalent at the same height.

Individual qualifications- it is the horse/rider combination that qualifies so no substitution is possible

Rules: NSEA General Rules 2018-19. (see (8) Eventing for specific rules)

Substitutions for the championships - a qualified team may substitute up two 2 riders at the final but these riders must have competed in one of the NSEA qualifying events or the BE equivalent at the same height.

Individual qualifications- it is the horse/rider combination qualify so no substitution is possible
