Class 1 Scurry 80/85 cm

Class 2 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 3 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

Classes 1 – 4 Entry Fee: £16 per round plus medical cover £4 per rider Cheques payable to SEEM

Ring 2- Sand Arena

Class 5 40cm Team & Individual Qualifier (may be led/assisted)

Class 6 50cm Team & Individual Qualifier (may be assisted)
