- Class 2B Walk & Trot Introductory A (2008) (unassisted)
- Class 3A Prelim 2 (2016) (may be led/assisted)
- Class 3B Prelim 2 (2016) (may not be assisted)
- Class 4 Prelim 7 (2002) (may not be assisted)
- **In led/assisted classes an assistant may run alongside the pony, however, they must not attempt to affect the outline of the pony and the rider should be steering.
