Class 1: 60cm Team & Individual

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Dressage: Introductory B, SJ and XC max height 60cm, XC not timed

Entry Fee: £42.00 (inc vat + £2.00 fist aid)

Class 2: 70cm Team & Individual

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Dressage: BE 96 (2016), SJ and XC max height 70cm, XC optimum time 400m/min

Entry Fee: £52.00 (inc vat + £2.00 fist aid)

Class 3: 80cm Team & Individual

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Dressage: BE 96 (2016), SJ and XC max height 80cm, XC optimum time 435m/min.

Entry Fee: £62.00 (inc vat + £2.00 fist aid)

Class 4: 90cm Team & Individual

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Dressage test: BE 96 (2016), SJ and XC max height 90cm, XC optimum time 450m/min.

Entry Fee: £62.00 (inc vat + £2.00 fist aid)

Rules- NSEA General Rules 2017-18 & British Eventing Rules 2019

The list of qualifiers are listed on the NSEA website.

Top 3 teams & top 8 individuals per section to qualify for the 2019 Championship

Substitution- a qualified team may substitute up to two riders at the final but these riders must have competed in one of the 10 qualifying events or the BE equivalent at the same height.

Individual qualifications- it is the horse/rider combination that qualify so no substitution is possible

Disclaimer:
