TRAINING ARENA To start at 9am promptly

Class 1 Warm Up Class 60-65cm Team & Individual

Please note: This class is not open to riders in the outdoor arena

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2019)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Mini 70-75cm Team and Individual Qualifier

Riders minimum age 8 years, maximum U14 on 1st January 2019

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals. Riders under 19 years on 1st January 2019

OUTDOOR ARENA To start at 9am promptly

Class 4 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals. Riders under 19 years on 1st January 2019

Class 5 1m-1.05m Open Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals. Riders under 19 years on 1st January 2019

Class 6a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier

This class will be split into 6a) Horses and 6b) Ponies

Single Phase. Riders under 19 years on 1st January 2019

DISCLAIMER

The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. Any damages must be paid for. Vehicles, boxes and trailers are parked entirely at the owner's risk.

The organisers will not be liable for any claims in respect of damage, loss or injury to any person, whether spectator or competitor, horse or property howsoever caused, in connection with or arising out of the competition.

Horses may only be ridden by the NSEA competitor; they must not be ridden or warmed up by anyone else.

The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor whose riding helmet is not fastened when mounted. Riding helmets must be worn by anybody riding a horse or pony for any reason. It is mandatory that protective helmets are manufactured to: **British** All PAS 015, VG1}, **European** VG1} Provided they are BSI Kite Marked, **American** – All SEI ASTM F1163 04a onwards and SNELL E2001, **Australian & New Zealand** – AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. Competitors are strongly advised to check their hats regularly, or take them to a reputable hat supplier to be checked. We recommend that hats are replaced following a fall or checked after any impact. The organisers strongly recommend that competitors wear body protectors.

PRIZE-GIVING

Prize-giving for all classes will take place (unmounted) in the covered spectator area outside the café. We would ask that all riders and teams either attend, or are represented at the prize-giving ceremony or unfortunately their prizes will be forfeited. Riders attending should be correctly dressed.

SCORING

Teams of 3 or 4 with the best 3 scores to count (all team members will automatically count as individuals).

Trophies for winning team and individual in each class. Rosettes for teams and individuals to 6th place.

Best turned out rosette to be awarded in each class.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The judge's decision is final. Entry fees cannot be refunded without a Vet or Doctor's certificate. In any event, £5 will be retained to cover administration costs. No entry will be accepted without the correct fee and signed entry forms for all competitors.

RULES

- This event will run under BSJA Single Phase Competition rules (Course in two parts with second part timed. Competitors to jump both parts unless eliminated. Two refusals will result in elimination). Faults to be accumulated.
- Classes will run as teams first then individuals.
- Competitors are responsible for being ready to compete when called.
- Age of competitors as at 1st January 2019.
- Teams must consist of at least 3 different riders. A rider may only compete once in each team.
- No horse may compete in more than 3 classes or be ridden more than once in each class. No horse may compete in more than 2 NSEA Qualifier classes.
- All riders must be in full time education at the school or college they represent on the date of the competition.
- The 30cm rule applies to classes 1, 2, 3 and 4.
- Only the Team Manager of each school is to deal with the Secretary for declarations, enquiries, objections etc. Objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the relevant class with a £30 deposit. Video or photographic evidence is not admissible.
- Declarations are to be made at least 10 minutes before the start of each class, by the Team Manager. No changes may be made after the start of the class.
- Anyone entering this competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules in this schedule and on the NSEA website.
- **All schools to provide their own arena party when their pupils are competing.**
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, in which case entry fees will be refunded (less £2 per competitor).
- In the event of adverse weather conditions, please check the school website for information.
- Competitors will only be able to walk the course at the beginning of each class.

Stallions may compete at school competitions with prior permission from the organiser before the closure date. A stallion disk must be worn.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition.

All enquiries are to be made by the Team Manager please.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Take all litter home with you. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times and any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground.

All competitors, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.

PARAMEDICS will be in attendance.

VET There will be a vet on call for the duration of the competition.

REFRESHMENTS will be available all day from the café.
