Conditions of Entry

OPEN TO ALL NSEA RIDERS

This is an inter-schools competition and is open to NSEA members from schools in all counties.

TEAM & INDIVIDUAL CLASSES

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. All riders automatically count as individuals. Horse/Pony & Rider combination must never have been placed 1st in any BE, Riding Club, Pony Club or similar event at the fence heights for the class. Riders competing in the Novice, Intermediate and Open can not compete in the Mini classes.

PRIZES

- Individual Rosettes: 1st 10th place in each class
- Team Rosettes: 1st 3rd place in each class
- Prizes: For the overall Individual Winner of each class
- Trophies: For the overall Team Winners of each class
- Souvenir Rosettes: Presented to all competitors in the 40cm and 60cm Mini classes.

The prize giving for each class will be non-mounted and will take place as soon as the results are confirmed after each class finishes.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The 40cm and 60cm Mini classes are in a separate field on grass and are a single phase course made up of SJ and XC fences, including a small water complex. The competitors will not be timed but will be placed according to Style Marks awarded for:

General riding position
 Control and pace
 Use of correct jumping lines
 Table 25 marks
 Table 25 marks

The Novice, Intermediate and Open courses are on all surface arenas and are a single phase course made up of SJ and XC fences, including a water complex, with an optimum time and no style marks. Riders will jump a series of show jumps, proceeding immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time. Jumping penalties have priority over time faults – so you need to go clear to win! The top two Teams and Individuals qualify for the Eventers Challenge Championship 2019, at the All England Jumping Course, Hickstead.

Jumping penalties are awarded as follows:

Knockdown (to include SJ fences) 4 penalties 1st Refusal 4 penalties 2nd Refusal 8 penalties 3rd Refusal Elimination loker -4 Clear or +8 Knock Down O Clear or +4 Knock Down Non-Joker 1st Rider Fall Elimination Horse Fall Retirement Starting before the bell /Error of course Elimination Retaking an obstacle already jumped Elimination Every commenced second over 1 penalty

or under the optimum time

Exceeding time limit (3 x the time allowed) Elimination

In the event of a tie, the competitor closest to the optimum time will be the winner. If teams are tied, the times of the 3 best scores closest to the optimum time will be the winner.

RULES

NSEA General & Competition Rules 2019-20

OPTIMUM TIME

The Novice, Intermediate and Open classes will be run under an optimum time, Speed 325-375 metres / minute. The Mini 40cm and 60cm courses are not timed.

TIMING DEVICES

No timing equipment (including watches) may be worn, carried or used by riders during their round.

DRESS CODE

NSEA / BE Eventing Rules for tack and rider equipment for XC. Please bring your own competition number bib as only printed numbers will be provided.

HARD HATS/BODY PROTECTORS

Body protectors are compulsory. Hair must be above collar length, long hair to be kept in place in a hair net. Rider must wear BE approved skull caps, no fixed peak SJ hats.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The Organisers reserve the right to:

- Cancel the event, in which case entry fees will be refunded
- Alter the Show Jumping/Cross Country course if necessary

After 9th October 2019 fees will only be refunded on presentation of a veterinary or medical certificate.
