Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Test: Novice 24 (2010) (revised collective marks 2016) Individual qualifier only The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level. The winning individual from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA National County Finals.
