Class 3 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 6ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier a) horses and b) ponies Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony section of the class, as the class will be split. Rules- See NSEA Additional Rules for qualifiers 2018-19

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.
