

## RULES

Classes 2, 3, 5 & 7 are Qualifying classes and open to teams of 3 or 4 (best 3 scores to count) and individuals. Numbers in each class will be limited and there will be provision for a number of individual competitors in each class. All team members are judged as individuals as well. Classes 4, 6 & 8 are Individual classes and Open to all

**All schools must be members of the National Schools Equestrian Association (NSEA) - please also refer to NSEA Rules via their website [www.nsea.org.uk](http://www.nsea.org.uk).**

The competition will be run in accordance with British Showjumping Rules 2019

Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary by the Team Manager only, within 20 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £30, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

It is essential that everybody obeys the Officials and Stewards at all times. Only those directly involved with the people jumping or about to jump will be allowed in the collecting area. All other spectators must watch from the viewing gallery.

Dogs will be allowed at the venue but must be kept on a short lead AT ALL TIMES. Dogs are not allowed in the warm up arena, main arena or Cafe Area or shop.

Start times will be available from the Kings website three days before the event.

**The Organisers of this event have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. - CLASS 3 60cm TEAM & INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (may NOT be assisted)
- CLASS 4 65cm INDIVIDUAL CLASS - open to all
- CLASS 5 70cm TEAM & INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (may NOT be assisted)
- CLASS 6 75cm Introductory Individual Class (may NOT be assisted) (Not a qualifying class) Open to all
