CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

All riders must have attended the school they are representing on the day that they qualified. New riders can only be added as substitutes (max 2 per team). There must be 2 of the original horse/rider combinations in each team. Riders who left school at the end of the academic year can still compete for their original school. All schools must be current NSEA members. Please quote NSEA number on entry form (www.nsea.co.uk).

NON-CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

All riders entering non-Championship classes must be attending the school they are representing on the date of the competition, and all schools must be current NSEA members. Please quote NSEA number on entry form (www.nsea.co.uk).

OVERSUBSCRIBED CLASSES

In the event of a ballot non-Championship classes will be balloted before Championship classes.

RULES

As for NSEA General Rules 2018-19 (see (8) Eventing for specific rules) and under the guidelines of British Eventing 2019, except:

- Riders do not need to be registered with BE
- Half chaps (no tassels) black or brown may be worn with standard jodhpur boots of the same colour. No hooded tops allowed.
- School Numnahs and Jackets, will be permitted.
- All hats must be tagged. BE/PC/RC acceptable. Any untagged hats should be taken to the Secretary before competing.

The list of Qualifiers are listed on the NSEA website.

SUBSTITUTION

A qualified team may substitute up to two riders at the Final but these riders must have competed at the same height (but not necessarily an NSEA Qualifier). The Team Manager must provide a covering letter of rider competence.

INDIVIDUAL QUALIFICATIONS

It is the horse/rider combination to qualify so no substitution is possible.

VACCINATIONS

All horses to have a current flu vaccination in accordance with NSEA General Rules.

WITHDRAWALS

Close on Tuesday 17th September 2019 at 1800 hours, preferably by email to <u>rachel.adderley@btinternet.com</u> or leave a clear message on 01249 740382. PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT STONAR SCHOOL.

PRIZES

Trophies to winning teams and individuals. NSEA Championship rugs to winning teams and individuals. Rosettes and prizes will be dependent on entries. Prize winners are expected to attend the prize giving and if for genuine reasons they cannot stay they must nominate another person to collect their prize. In the team classification, although we would prefer the whole team to attend, if only one or two team members, or a nominated representative, can stay that is acceptable. Prizes not collected at the prize giving will be forfeited.

ENTRY FEES

£190 per Team (of 3 or 4 members) £60 per Individual. Cheques made payable to STONAR SCHOOL.

NUMBERS

There will be paper numbers, so you will be required to bring your own number bibs. We will have bibs available for hire, on receipt of a £10.00 returnable deposit. CORRECT CASH ONLY PLEASE.

START FEES

There will be a £15.00 start fee payable in cash when collecting numbers.

ENTRY FORM

Please either download and print pdf version for postal entries or open and complete electronic (excel) version.

Please complete all fields clearly especially: **School** - Please put your full school name ie: St Trinians, Barchester; etc. **Team Name / Indiv.** Indicate if entry is a member of a team – T, or is an Individual – I. If you have more than one team then give each team a name ie: Blue, Green; A, B, C; Senior, Junior, Mini. Entries will close on Wednesday I I th September 2019 at 12:00 hrs and should be either attached to an email to rachel.adderley@btinternet.com (Chq Ref as Subject), or posted to the Entries Secretary - Rachel Adderley NOT the School. Entries will not be deemed as provisionally accepted until payment is received. In the event of oversubscription schools will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries. Entries may be limited, so please list entries in priority order. We will of course try and take as many as we can.

Any horse/rider changes must be sent by email to the Secretary from the team manager or person in charge of the entries only. Changes from a third party will not be accepted.

PAYMENT

Payment can be made by cheque or BACS Transfer. Please write details of entries on the back of cheques, ie. Class/Name/School. If paying by BACS it is essential that the BACS reference (max 18 characters) includes the school name. Please complete the "Bank Details" box on entry form in case refunds have to be made. REFUNDS

No refunds after close of entries without a Vets/Doctors Certificate, which must be received by the Secretary within 48 hours of the withdrawal, no refunds at all after close of withdrawals, and no rider / horse changes after close of withdrawals on Tuesday 17th September 2019.

Please DO NOT send entries by special delivery. Please ensure all entry forms and commentator slips are completed in full. Entry Forms must have phone numbers including a mobile and an email address. Information will be available on the website as soon after close of entries as possible. Please direct all entry queries to the secretary NOT the school. Preferably by email.

DIRECTIONS TO STONAR

By road from the M4 (30 minutes):

Leave M4 at J17. At Stanton Saint Quinton roundabout take the 2nd exit on to the A350 signed "Chippenham, Poole". Follow the A350 signposted "Warminster" all the way through to Melksham. Go straight over the mini roundabout and at the next roundabout turn right onto the B3107 signposted to "Bradford on Avon". After 1.4 miles, turn right (opposite a red brick house) into Mill Lane. Continue straight on through village of Broughton Gifford. Approximately I mile after the village, you will come to a crossroads and straight ahead is the driveway to Stonar.

By road from Bath (20 minutes):

Follow A4 out of Bath. At Box take the A360 Devizes Road. At the 'Five-ways' traffic lights turn right towards Bradford on Avon onto the B3109. Turn left where signposted to "Stonar School" and "Atworth" (the turning is immediately before a garage and the right-hand turn is signposted "South Wraxall"). Continue along this road until you reach a crossroads. Turn left into the driveway to Stonar.

By road from A303 (south):

From eastbound A303 take A350 turn off north signposted "Warminster". From westbound A303 take A36 turn off signposted "Warminster". On reaching Warminster bypass take A350 via Westbury and Trowbridge to Melksham. Turn left at roundabout where A350 meets B3107 to Bradford on Avon. Follow directions above (from M4).

Please could horse lorries try to avoid going through the village of Atworth when coming to and from Stonar.
