**Class 1** Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 40cm. Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

**Class 2** Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 50cm. Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

**Class 3** Grass Roots Qualifier Teams and Individuals – Fences 60cm. Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

Class 4 Grass Roots Qualifier Individual – Fences 70cm. Single Phase. (For the NSEA East of England Grass Roots Regional Final)

**Class 5** Mini Team & Individual (RPL) – Fences 70cm. Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

**Class 6** Novice Team & Individual (RPL) - Fences 80cm. Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

**Class 7** Intermediate Teams & Individual (RPL) - Fences 90cm. Teams to consist of 3-4 riders from the same school. Single Phase.

**Class 8** Open Individual (RPL) Fences 95cm-1m. Single Phase.
