

RULES

Numbers in each class will be limited and there will be provision for a number of individual competitors in each class.

All schools must be members of the National Schools Equestrian Association (NSEA) - please also refer to NSEA Rules via their website www.nsea.org.uk

The competition will be run in accordance with British Showjumping Rules 2020.

At Grassroots Classes:- A rider may ride 2 ponies/ horses in the same team providing the school has only one team in the class. Two riders may ride the same pony/horse providing the school has only one team in the class.

PONIES CAN BE RIDDEN A MAXIMUM OF 4 ROUNDS DURING THE DAY, PROVIDING IT IS SHARED BETWEEN RIDERS WHO ARE COMPETING AT DIFFERENT HEIGHTS. A PONY MAY NOT COMPETE WITH THE SAME 2 RIDERS IN 2 TEAMS AT 2 HEIGHTS

Any objections must be made to the Organiser/Secretary by the Team Manager only, within 20 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £20, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

It is essential that everybody obeys the Officials and Stewards at all times. Only one Team Manager will be allowed in the collecting area to adhere to COVID rules.

Start times will be available from the Kings website three days before the event.

The Organisers of this event have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of ALL THE OFFICIALS AND STEWARDS. Anyone in breach of this will be asked to leave the premises.

Important Notice:

Horse/rider combinations who have qualified to compete at the Grassroots Regional Championships but have since jumped 80cm or above are eligible to compete in the 60, 70 and 75cm classes only.

ALL TEAM ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST 2 OF THE ORIGINAL QUALIFYING TEAM MEMBERS

ONCE A RIDER HAS COMPETED AT 90CM ON ANY HORSE
THEY ARE NO LONGER A GRASSROOTS RIDER AND MAY
NOT TAKE PART IN THIS CHAMPIONSHIP

CLASS 1 Clear Round £5, Class 3A £12
REGIONAL FINAL CLASSES £20 per rider/per round
(All entry fees include medic charges)

Substitutions may be made, but no refunds will be given, after the close of entry date. No team changes will be accepted on the day.
