Important Information for Team Managers.

Please read thoroughly.
Team Managers are required to know this important information.

1. All **entries** and **enquiries** regarding this championship to **NSEA only**.
2. All **stabling & hook ups** to be booked only through the **Keysoe website**. All other enquiries to NSEA
We recommend that each school block books stables for all riders in their squad. Please designate 1 person per school / college to book stabling and send all paperwork and payments at same time if you wish to stable together.
3. Only teams and individuals qualified for the championships are eligible to compete at this event. Team Managers send the DECLARATION FORM to fw.nsea@gmail.com as soon as you have made your entries
4. **Please read rules carefully for eligibility for all disciplines at the show.**
All Rules for the Championship classes and qualification rules for teams can be found on the NSEA website.
5. The **Team Manager** is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties (parents, supporters etc) at **all times** on the show ground.
No wristbands are necessary for this competition.
6. **Directions** to Keysoe and a list of local hotels and B&B's can be found on the Keysoe website
7. In accordance with Health and Safety Regulations, dogs will only be permitted in the car and lorry parks. **(Dogs are not allowed in the competition or public areas, main building, cafeteria or stable barn)**
8. Leave stable mucked out. All hay & droppings must be removed. All stable bookings close a week before the show.
9. No BBQs or chimneas in the lorry park.
10. Hook ups to be arranged with Keysoe.
11. **Include with your entries an A5 SAE with large first class stamp. Include the Information sheet with SAE You will be sent security wristbands for competitors and all other persons attached to the team, which you will need to get into the show ground.**
12. All jumping courses will be raised 5cm from the qualifiers, at the Championships.
13. In the event of cancellation, entry fees shall be returned on receipt of a SAE, less £5 per competitor per class to help cover costs.
14. **After 10p.m, the stable area should be quiet.** Please be aware that horses need to rest and therefore noise, lighting and intrusion should be kept to an absolute minimum. Late night checks should be conducted prior to 10p.m.
15. A contact number must be left on the stable door of every horse in case of an emergency.
16. The restaurant will be serving hot evening meals as well as food all day. There are showers in the stable area for those staying on site. Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must ask the stable manager where it may be pitched. No fires or camping gas cookers in the lorry park or stable field.
17. The end of the show will be 1 hour after the last horse has jumped

Horses may not arrive after 10pm and before 6am unless by prior arrangement with the stable office as the stable area will be closed.

Stabling is now on the same side of the road as the show ground. Showers are also available.

Keysoe Equestrian and the NSEA reserve the right to refuse entry to, and remove, any individual without giving a reason.

Eligibility

The following competitors are eligible for this Championships

Top 3 – 6 placed teams & 5 – 8th placed individuals in all NSEA Championships Qualifiers from Sept 2020 to October 2021 are eligible to compete at the NSEA Championships Plate

Online dressage qualifiers- all marked Q to qualify

Wildcard entries- only wildcards offered on the day are eligible

NSEA Coronavirus Protocol - Autumn 2021 *(will be updated prior to the competition)*

We request that everyone attending this competition needs to take a lateral flow test before leaving home, in order to help to keep transmission across schools as low as possible.

HEALTH CHECKS

1. *If any competitor, or anybody in their household, is showing symptoms of Coronavirus, they must not attend any NSEA event without taking a PCR test and receiving a negative result.*

On the morning of the competition, prior to departure, there should be the following simple health check conducted:

1. *Take the temperature of everybody in the household. If anybody has a temperature of over 37.8 degrees, then please seek medical advice and do not attend.*
2. *Is anybody in the household quarantined because of foreign travel to a country which is not exempt? If so, please do not attend.*
3. *If anybody in the household has any of the following symptoms then please seek medical advice, and do not attend:*
 1. *A persistent cough;*
 2. *A loss of taste or smell;*
 3. *A temperature (see 1(1) above)*

AT THE SHOW CENTRE

2. *One person per squad should take charge of ensuring social distancing to ensure that everybody keeps their distance. They should familiarise themselves with one-way systems and protocols specific to each venue which will be available. Regular reminders will need to be given as it is easy to forget things when both on, and off, a horse. Remember to avoid sharing equipment. Household groups - or bubbles - should be maintained when moving around and please follow show centre instructions. Check in advance, for example, to see what, if any, catering facilities are available and plan accordingly.*
3. *Avoid touching surfaces like jumps or rails, and follow instructions given by show centres.*
4. *Do not forget to use hand sanitiser on arrival. Show centres will be providing this, but if there are shortages it is obviously sensible to bring your own which should be used regularly. Practise good hand-hygiene as often as possible throughout the day; show centres will all have soap and hot water available.*
5. *Any person at the event who becomes unwell should immediately isolate with their household, and if necessary should seek medical attention from the Paramedic team in attendance at NSEA events. The household with the unwell person in should leave the show centre to return home.*

HEALTH CHECK BEFORE YOU LEAVE

KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

PRACTISE GOOD HAND HYGIENE

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Horses must not be left tied to vehicles unattended. Take all litter home with you.

All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination.

NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitors, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times- most of them are volunteers and give up their time for your sport.

Refunds- only with a vet cert / doctors note, less £5 per entry admin fee.

The NSEA will not be held responsible for any financial loss incurred by any entrant, their associates or attendees as a result of a re-arrangement to the schedule, postponement or cancellation of a competition. Competitors must have permission from their school to compete

In the event of cancellation, you entry will be refunded on receipt of an email, less £5 per entry admin fee.

Classes

In order to reduce numbers on site at any time, we are aiming to run the 80 & 90 EC classes over 2 days.

This will hopefully enable competitors who are competing at two heights, to compete in both classes on the same day.

Competitors will be given times for their competition rounds and their warm ups. Horses will be expected to be taken back to boxes after each round. All classes and jumping warm ups are on sand surfaces.

Stabling

Parents must be in attendance. No-one under the age of 19 may be left on site without a parent. Horse boxes / tents need to be for family groups from the same residence.

Warm Up areas

8 horses will be allowed into the various warm up areas at any time. A marked hacking area will also be available. Exercised areas will be marked. **Riders may not hack around the fields.**

1 adult in the warm up area at a time to put up jumps. Please ensure that they are available for everyone - do not hog them! Use the hand sanitiser before entering the warm up area.

Numbers

Arena Eventing classes. Please make your own number and display in your own eventing bib.

Dressage & SJ classes may print numbers or bring a bridle number for each horse. No paper numbers will be given out this year.

Prize givings

There will be official **unmounted prize giving's. Riders must be correctly dressed to receive prizes.**

Horse walks Single file at all times, pass left to left and no loitering around entrance / exits !

Facemasks

Please bring a face mask per person, as per government guidelines nearer the time. Face masks may be needed for stable areas, course walks and catering areas.
