Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 1 round, single phase.



Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Qualifier

The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead 2022
Individual 1.10m qualifiers for section a) horses and section b) ponies (separate sections)
Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section. 1 round single phase.

Open to all. 30cm rule applies. Scores count for the NSEA RPL. Single Phase.



CLASS FOUR: 100cm incl Hickstead Elite 1m Team Qualifier

Terms and Conditions

The competition will be run under the British Show Jumping Rules 2019 & NSEA Rules as set out on the NSEA website, but the organiser has the discretion to change the rules, if it is required. **N.B. The NSEA 30cm Rule applies to all classes.**

The best three scores will count in the team competitions. Rosettes awarded to 6th place for teams and to 10th place for individuals in all classes. All riders are to be from the same school.

School logos are permitted.

Riders must be in full time education at the school/college they represent in the 2020/21 academic year and 18 or under on 1st January 2021.

A rider may only compete once in any team, and therefore cannot compete two horses in the same team.

Horse/rider combination may only compete in a maximum of two classes.

A rider may not compete in both classes 1 and 5.

Team members will automatically also be entered as individuals and their score, gained whilst riding as a team member, will also automatically count as their individual score when determining the individual placings.

A two-minute warning given to riders not ready to jump at their allotted time before elimination.

Objections must be made in writing, accompanied by a £20 deposit, by the TEAM MANAGER within 5 minutes of the end of the class.

Only the TEAM MANAGER is to deal with the secretary.

There will be no refunds after the closing date.

Declarations are to be made 15 minutes before the class starts. There will be no changes to declared entries after the class has begun.

Dogs are not allowed.

Neither the organizers nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property whatsoever.

The organizer of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
