The top team will qualify to compete at Hickstead 2026 Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 1 round, single phase. Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Qualifier The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead 2026 Individual 1.10m qualifiers for section a) horses and section b) ponies (separate sections)

Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section. 1 round single phase.

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points.
All classes are single phase.
