Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. All team riders also automatically count for individual placings.

Special award for the highest placed U11 rider on Jan 1st 2020 in this class (if eligible, please state DOB on the Entry form)

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse & rider combinations with 21 BD points or less, gained together at novice level. Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 7 Individual Novice County Qualifier

Test: Novice 24 (2010) (revised collective marks 2016) Individual qualifier only

Special award for the highest placed U14 rider in this class (if eligible, please state DOB on the Entry form)

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.
