**\*\*Class 5a & 5b Windsor Qualifiers are the same class which will run over the two days. The highest placed 2 teams will qualify to compete at Windsor in May 2020. Schools competing in classes 1 - 4 should take part on Saturday and those competing on Sunday should opt for 5b. Riders may only compete once in this class.**

All show jumping classes are single phase

Eventers Challenge

The course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks. Larger arenas may use secured XC portables. Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 325- 375m/m.

**Entry Fee: £18 per horse/rider combination per round in all classes**

**Paramedic First Aid Cover £4 per rider for the day.**
