Class 4 Intermediate 90cm Team & Individual County Qualifier Team & Individual Qualifier for the County Finals at Hartpury College 18-19 April 2020

Class 5 1m Team & Individual County Qualifier

The top 2 teams will qualify to compete at Hickstead (date to be confirmed for 2020) Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count. 1 round, single phase.



Class 6ab 1.10m Individual County Qualifier. Class split into a) horses and b) ponies for the County Finals at Hartpury College 18-19 April 2020 & Qualifier for the Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Championships.

The top 2 horses & ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead (date to be confirmed for 2020)

Individual 1.10m qualifiers for horses and ponies (separate sections) Distances will be shortened in combinations for the pony section. 1 round single phase.

All classes will be run as a BS Single Phase Competition (course in two parts with second part timed). The competitor is to jump both parts unless eliminated. Three refusals will result in elimination. Faults to be accumulated.

- All team members will automatically compete for individual prizes aswell.
- Entry fee: **£18** per round per competitor. Late entries £3 extra if space.
- Entry fee includes First Aid.

Prizes: Individual rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place in each class.

Team rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ in each class.

Please ask parents of every rider to undergo the following brief health check <u>prior</u> to leaving home in order to help us to minimise the spread of Coronavirus

1. Make sure that all competitors and their families are not breaching lockdown quarantine measures. If anyone within the household of a rider who is competing shows any symptoms of coronavirus, please stay home.

2 The attending parent needs to undertake a brief health check on the morning of the competition. - Take the temperature of everyone planning to attend the competition

Has anyone suffered from a persistent cough, loss of taste or smell or have a fever / temperature?
If anyone has a temperature over 37.8, the household should seek advice and must not attend the competition.

3 Make sure that you have allocated an adult in charge of your squad social distancing and one way systems at the event. They will need to keep reminding everyone as it is easy to forget both on and off the horse. It is important that we keep everyone in small groups or 'bubbles' so please follow show centre instructions.

4 Don't forget your hand sanitiser (use it on arrival at the venue) & PPE. Venues are providing hand sanitiser, but if there are shortages, they could run out. Teams need to be prepared, if this happens. 5 If anyone becomes unwell at the event, isolate them & the party they travelled with away from the rest of the riders and seek medical help. Paramedics are in attendance at NSEA events.

6 Limit numbers of personnel. No spectators at events. One parent per competitor where possible. 7 Please leave the venue AFTER COMPETING in order to make space for others. Results will be posted on-line only.
