#### **Flu Vaccinations- IMPORTANT**

#### D13) Vaccinations.

All horses/ ponies competing in NSEA events must be vaccinated against equine influenza as follows

- a) Two injections for the primary vaccination not less than 21 days or more than 92 days apart. Both are required before a horse/ pony may compete.
- b) A booster injection given 150 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination
- c) Subsequent booster injections must be given each year, within and not exceeding the one year period, commencing after the first booster injection.

IN ADDITION TO THE NSEA GENERAL RULES, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED WITHIN
6 MONTHS TO COMPETE AT THIS EVENT AS HORSES ARE TRAVELLING FROM ALL COUNTIES AND HAVE 5
CLEAR DAYS FROM THE LAST VACCINATION

Each team of four at the Championships must include two out of the original qualified four horse/rider combinations. However, if, in exceptional circumstances, a previously qualified team has only one of the original horse/rider combinations remaining, the School may be permitted, at the discretion of the NSEA, to substitute two new horse/rider combinations to make up a team of three

- 1. All **entries** and **enquiries** regarding this championships to **NSEA only.** Email <a href="mailto:fw.nsea@gmail.com">fw.nsea@gmail.com</a> Hartpury Equine are not dealing with any show enquiries other than stabling & catering.
- 2. All stabling to be booked only through Hartpury Equine <a href="www.equineaffairs.com/eventdetails.aspx?id=311279">www.equineaffairs.com/eventdetails.aspx?id=311279</a>

If a school wishes to have stables allocated together please designate 1 person per school / college to book stabling and send all paperwork and cheques in at same time.

- 3. Only teams and individuals qualified for the championships are eligible to compete.
- 4. Please read rules carefully for eligibility for all disciplines at the show.
  All Rules for the Championship classes and qualification rules for teams can be found on the NSEA website.
- 5. The **Team Manager** is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties. (parents, supporters etc.) at **all times** on the show ground.

Supporters are encouraged but entry is by wristband only and these must be purchased in advance using the Championships Passes Form.

- 6. Directions to Hartpury College and a list of local hotels and B&B's can be found on the Hartpury website
- 7. No dogs anywhere except car & lorry parks
- 8. No BBQs or chimneas in lorry park.
- 9. Hook ups to be arranged with Hartpury Equine
- 10. Include with your entries an A4 SAE with large two first class stamps. You will be sent security wristbands for competitors and all other persons attached to the team, which you will need to get into the show ground.
- 11. All jumping courses may be raised up to 5cm from the qualifiers, at the Championships.
- 12. In the event of cancellation, entry fees shall be returned on receipt of a SAE, less £5 per competitor per class to help cover costs.
- 13. **After 10p.m, the stable area should be quiet**. Please be aware that horses need to rest and therefore noise, lighting and intrusion should be kept to an absolute minimum. Late night checks should be conducted prior to 10p.m.
- 14. A contact number must be left on a piece of paper on the stable door of every horse in case of an emergency.
- 15. Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must check with Hartpury prior to arrival and ask the stable manager where it may be pitched. No fires or camping gas cookers in the lorry park or stable field.
- 16. Horses should not arrive after 10pm and before 6am. Hartpury and the NSEA reserve the right to refuse entry to, and remove, any individual without giving a reason.
- 17. The end of the show will be deemed to be half an hour after the last horse competes.
- 18. The NSEA will not be held responsible for any financial loss incurred by any entrant, their associates or attendees as a result of a re-arrangement to the schedule, postponement or cancellation of this competition.

Please help us to ensure that this Championship is run in the true spirit of competition and fair play.

In order to compete in events listed on the NSEA website, all competing schools must now be members of the NSEA, and show their membership number on entry forms. For full details of how to join go to www.nsea.org.uk

Entries must be made in advance, late entries to be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, for any reason.

Competitors must wear correct clothing and tack in accordance with NSEA & BD/ BS rules.

Lungeing is not permitted in any working area. No adults to warm up horses on the show ground.

The decision of the judges is final.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

All riders MUST wear hard hats, correctly fitting and to the latest BSI specifications according to the rules with the chin strap done up whilst mounted. All dressage hats must have a fitted chin strap.

Whilst not compulsory, we recommend that riders wear a body protector whilst jumping.

Any objections must be made, by the Team Manager, to the organiser within 5 minutes of the completion of the event, in writing on an official adjudication form, accompanied by a deposit of £30 which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
