Class 1 50cm Open Class Individuals Only

Class 2 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots EC Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Introductory 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots EC Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 4 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 5 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual (Hickstead qualifier)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Classes 2 & 3 are new classes for 2020- Grass Roots Regional Final Qualifiers

60cm Grass Roots classes will be single phase competitions, no outside assistance. There will be an award for the best rider under 8yrs on 1st Jan 2020. Horse/ Rider <u>combinations</u> who have **completed** courses at 80cm (at ANY competition, not just NSEA competitions) may only compete h/c in 60cm classes, or they must ride a different pony.

70cm Grass Roots classes. Single phase, no outside assistance Riders jumping at this level are not eligible for 40cm Grass Roots on ANY pony.

Classes 4 & 5 are Qualifiers for Hickstead

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count

Entry Fee for class 1 - £14 per rider per round which includes medical cover Entry Fee for classes 2-5 £19 per rider per round which includes medical cover

Strictly no refund of entry fees after the closing date.

Winter Eventers Challenge 2019-20

The Course is made up of SJ & simulated XC fences with an optimum time & no style marks. Riders will jump a series of show jumps and then proceed immediately into the XC phase which is run on an optimum time of 350-375m/m.



NSEA Eventers Challenge Rules for Scoring 2020

The intention of these rules is to reward riders who have a clear round and to penalise riders who have jumping penalties or who are significantly faster than the Optimum Time. Where there are several competitors with a clear round, then the nearest to the Optimum Time will win, rewarding an appropriate judgement of pace around the course. The optimum time for each class will be displayed at the Secretary's desk on the day of the competition.

Penalties are awarded as follows

Knockdown (to include SJ and knockable xc fences)	4 penalties
1st Refusal	4 penalties
2nd Refusal	8 penalties
3rd Refusal	Elimination
Rider Fall	Elimination
Horse Fall	Elimination
Starting before the bell, retaking an obstacle already jumped, error of	Elimination
course or outside assistance	
Where the Optimum Time is 120 seconds or less, for every	1 penalty
commenced second in excess of 10 seconds under the optimum time	
Where the Optimum Time more than 120 seconds, for every	1 penalty
commenced second in excess of 15 seconds under the optimum time	
Exceeding time limit (2 times the Optimum Time)	Elimination
