Entries Close: Monday 20th July 2020 or when classes full — entries will be on a first-come basis and a wait list will be held. These classes will run in the 80m x 65m Fibretrack and 60m x 45m sand and fibre outdoor arenas (depending on entries).

Clear round – will run if time permits for an hour in each arena before the start of the classes - £5 per round. Confirmation after close of entries.

Class 1 GR 40cm Team & Individual Championship (may be led/assisted)

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 GR 50cm Team & Individual Championship (may be assisted) Single Phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 GR 60cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted)

Single Phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Introductory 70cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted)

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 5 Open 75cm Individual (may not be assisted). Pre-qualification not required for this class.

Classes 2-4 will also have a style prize awarded to the rider with the best style round.

Entry Fee - £18 per class (includes First Aid). Late entries £3 extra if space permits.

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules)

Prizes: Individual rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place in each class. Team rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ in each class.

Please ask parents of every rider to undergo the following brief health check <u>prior</u> to leaving home in order to help us to minimise the spread of Coronavirus

- 1. Make sure that all competitors and their families are not breaching lockdown quarantine measures. If anyone within the household of a rider who is competing shows any symptoms of coronavirus, please stay home.
- 2 The attending parent needs to undertake a brief health check on the morning of the competition.
- Take the temperature of everyone planning to attend the competition
- Has anyone suffered from a persistent cough, loss of taste or smell or have a fever / temperature?

- If anyone has a temperature over 37.8, the household should seek advice and must not attend the competition.
- 3 Make sure that you have allocated an adult in charge of your squad social distancing and one way systems at the event. They will need to keep reminding everyone as it is easy to forget both on and off the horse. It is important that we keep everyone in small groups or 'bubbles' so please follow show centre instructions carefully.
- 4 Don't forget your hand sanitiser (use it on arrival at the venue) & PPE. Venues are providing hand sanitiser, but if there are shortages, they could run out. Teams need to be prepared, if this happens.
- 5 If anyone becomes unwell at the event, isolate them & the party they travelled with away from the rest of the riders and seek medical help. Paramedics are in attendance at NSEA events.
- 6 Limit numbers of personnel. No spectators at events. One parent per competitor where possible.
- 7 Please leave the venue AFTER COMPETING in order to make space for others. Results will be posted on-line only.

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Take all litter home with you. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination.

NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.

In the event of cancellation, you entry will be refunded on receipt of a sae, less £5 per cheque admin fee. Have a good day!
