

# NSEA Pop Op Dressage Series 2 Spring League 2020

The rider with the most points in the NSEA Pop Op Series will win a Rug

The Top 8 riders from each Points League (classes 1, 2, 3 & 4) qualify for the Pop Up

Dressage (Spring) Championships

at the Championships Plate in November 2020

The aim of this series is to allow NSEA members to compete in a NSEA dressage league without leaving home!

Please follow government advice on Covid -19 restrictions.

Dressage Tests may be ridden in any  $20 \times 40 \text{m}$  arena on a surface or on grass. Individuals only. Tests may be called. Riders may not be coached during tests. Introductory riders may only compete in classes 1 & 2

#### To video

Tests must be videoed from the 'C' end of the arena and must be completed in one session, as you would in any competition.

Stand back approx. 3m from C, as if you were in the position of the dressage judge.

Make sure that the whole horse is in the video at all times (Tests may be videoed from a phone or camera) Put your video on YouTube - include your first name only and the name of your horse in your code.

Make sure that your password takes you to your YouTube video- please test that it works before you send off your entry form. Write your YouTube code **VERY CLEARLY** on your entry form.

#### To enter

- 1) Fill in the Entry Form and email your entry including your code which links your test to YouTube to competition@nsea.co.uk
  - Entries must arrive by the close of entries for the month as stated below. Open to NSEA members only. You may only submit one video per horse/rider combination per class.
- 2) Make an **online payment** for your entries SEEM Sort 40-44-37 Acc 62193906 with the reference: Pop/Class no's & riders surname Entry Fee £18 per test
- 3) Send a SAE if you wish to receive your dressage test sheet. Placings 1 6th at each competition. (Prizes for the winner of each class plus rosettes to 6th will be sent out on receipt of a sae)

Results will be posted on the NSEA website two weeks after the competition closure date. Envelopes for rosettes to: NSEA Pop-Up DR, PO Box 309, Mayfield, TN22 9FF

#### Note:

- Horse/Rider combinations may only compete in TWO consecutive tests ie 1 & 2, 2 & 3 or 3 & 4.
- -Classes 1 & 2 are restricted to riders who have not qualified to compete at the NSEA Championships, the County Dressage Championships, or have not been placed at the Pop up Final at Prelim level or above.
- -Class 1 Walk & Trot test is restricted to riders who are not competing in the second Prelim testtherefore may only compete in Class 1 and the first Prelim, class 2.
- -Riders competing at Elementary level may only compete in Class 4.
- Riders competing at Novice level may not compete in Classes 1 or 2
