Class 1 60 – 65cm Warm Up (Not a qualifying Class) Open to all.
Single phase.
£10/entry

Class 2 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier
(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2021)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.
£15/rider

Class 3 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.
£15/rider

Class 4 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals
£15/ rider

Class 5 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals
£15/rider

Class 6a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier
Single phase. This class will be split into 6a) Horses, 6b) Ponies
£15/rider

Team Managers- Coronavirus Protocols

Please ask **parents** of every rider to undergo the following brief health check prior to leaving home in order to help us to minimise the spread of Coronavirus. Help us to protect the sport we love.

1. Make sure that all competitors and their families are not breaching lockdown quarantine measures (if any are in place at the time of the event) If anyone within the household of a rider who is competing shows any symptoms of coronavirus, please stay home.

2 The attending **parent needs to undertake a brief health check** on the morning of the competition.

- Take the temperature of everyone planning to attend the competition
- Has anyone suffered from a persistent cough, loss of taste or smell or has a fever / temperature?
- If anyone has a temperature over 37.8, the household should seek advice and must not attend the competition.

3 Make sure that you have allocated an **adult in charge of your squad social distancing, who familiarises themselves with** one way systems & protocols at the venue. They will need to keep reminding everyone as it is easy to forget both on and off the horse. It is important that we **keep everyone in small groups or 'bubbles' and KEEP YOUR DISTANCE**, so please follow show centre instructions.

4 Don't forget your hand sanitiser (use it on arrival at the venue) & PPE. Venues are providing hand sanitiser, but if there are shortages, they could run out. Teams need to be prepared, if this happens.

5 If anyone becomes unwell at the event, isolate them & the party they travelled with away from the rest of the riders and seek medical help. Paramedics are in attendance at NSEA events.

General information

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Take all litter home with you.
All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination.
NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.

In the event of cancellation, your entry will be refunded on receipt of a sae, less £5 per entry admin fee.

In order to be allowed to compete, ALL horses (including companion horses) must have received a primary course of flu vaccinations (*a primary course is an initial vaccination followed by a second vaccination after no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days, **with the second of these vaccinations having been given no later than 7 days prior to the start of the competition.***)

Where the second vaccination of the primary course was completed more than 6 months prior to the start of the competition, every horse must have received continuous booster vaccinations, with the **FIRST** booster vaccine having been given between 150 and 215 days after the second vaccine of the primary course, and **EVERY** subsequent booster having being given within 1 year of the previous booster (*for example a horse vaccinated on 21/2/16 must have received its next booster on or before 21/02/17*).

Vaccinations given on the day of the event will **NOT** be considered as forming **ANY** part of the animal's vaccination history.

A significant number of passports will be checked and any horse found without a vaccination will be sent home.

Stabling
