IN ADDITION TO THE NSEA GENERAL RULES, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED WITHIN 12 MONTHS TO COMPETE AT THIS EVENT AS HORSES ARE TRAVELLING FROM ALL COUNTIES AND HAVE 7 CLEAR DAYS FROM THE LAST VACCINATION. All vaccinations must have been checked prior to the show. Email Moreton with the front cover and all vaccination pages from the primary two injections. If you have already competed with us since July 2020 we will hold a record.

It is the responsibility of Team Managers AND parents to read the NSEA General Rules 2020 thoroughly. Pay particular attention to the 30cm rule. Whilst we dislike doing so, we will eliminate anyone who is brought to our attention that has exceeded this or any other rule.

Due to coronavirus we will allow each team of four at the Championships to include ONE out of the original qualified four horse/rider combinations.

Individually qualified riders will jump once and pay once if they are also part of a team. Their score will count for both. Please highlight & add ** to those riders concerned on the Entry Form

Class 9 - NSEA Mini 70/75cm Team & Individual Oliver Bonas County Championships

Riders must be aged under 14yrs on 1st January 2020 to compete in this class.

NSEA Coronavirus Protocol - Autumn 2020

HEALTH CHECKS

1. If any competitor, or anybody in their household, is showing symptoms of Coronavirus, they must not attend any NSEA event. On the morning of the competition, prior to departure, there should be the following simple health check conducted:

1. Take the temperature of everybody in the household. If anybody has a temperature of over 37.8 degrees, then please seek medical advice and do not attend.
2. Is anybody in the household quarantined because of foreign travel to a country which is not exempt? If so, please do not attend.
3. If anybody in the household has any of the following symptoms then please seek medical advice, and do not attend:
 1. A persistent cough;
 2. A loss of taste or smell;
 3. A temperature (see 1(1) above)

REGIONAL LOCKDOWNS OR REGULATIONS

2. If any competitor lives, or stables their horse, in an area which has been made the subject of a specific geographical lockdown then please do not attend an event.
3. If the event is located within an area which is subject to specific conditions, we will review those, and may cancel an event at short notice if required to do so.
4. If the competitor's school is located in an area which is subject to specific conditions, even if the competitor lives outside that area, if they have physically attended the school in the two weeks prior to the competition, they should not attend.
5. For competitors who live near borders between England and Wales, or England and Scotland, please be mindful of the potentially differing rules once you cross a border, and familiarise yourself with those rules.

AT THE SHOW CENTRE

6. One person per squad should take charge of ensuring social distancing to ensure that everybody keeps their distance. They should familiarise themselves with one-way systems and protocols specific to each venue which will be available. Regular reminders will need to be given as it is easy to forget things when both on, and off, a horse. Remember to avoid sharing equipment. Household groups - or bubbles - should be maintained when moving around and please follow show centre instructions. Check in advance, for example, to see what, if any, catering facilities are available and plan accordingly.
7. Avoid touching surfaces like jumps or rails, and follow instructions given by show centres.
8. No spectators or supporters will be permitted. Just one parent/carers per competitor is encouraged wherever possible.
9. Do not forget to use hand sanitiser on arrival. Show centres will be providing this, but if there are shortages it is obviously sensible to bring your own which should be used regularly. Practise good hand-hygiene as often as possible throughout the day; show centres will all have soap and hot water available.

10. Any person at the event who becomes unwell should immediately isolate with their household, and if necessary should seek medical attention from the Paramedic team in attendance at NSEA events. The household with the unwell person in should leave the show centre to return home.
11. Please do not stay longer than is necessary for the competition. ARRIVE, COMPETE, LEAVE, in order to minimise the number of people at a show centre at any one time. All results will be published online.

BREACHES OF THE PROTOCOL

12. If breaches of this protocol are brought to the attention of show organisers, they will be permitted to demand the entire school's team leave the show centre, and may eliminate competitors. The NSEA will then consider whether to allow that school or competitor to compete in future competitions.
13. We are now recommending that everyone attending competitions should wear a face mask at all times unless mounted

Conditions of Entry 2020

Team Managers- please ensure that all horses / riders are correctly qualified for the classes they are entered for. All competitors, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Rudeness and unsportsmanlike behaviour are not acceptable and could result in elimination.

Please help us to ensure that this Championship is run in the true spirit of competition and fair play.

In order to compete in events listed on the NSEA website, all competing schools must be members of the NSEA, and show their membership number on entry forms. For full details of how to join go to www.nsea.org.uk

Entries must be made in advance, late entries to be accepted at the discretion of the organisers.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, for any reason.

Competitors must wear correct clothing and tack in accordance with NSEA & BD/ BS rules.

Lungeing is not permitted in any working area. No adults to warm up horses on the show ground.

The decision of the judges is final.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

All riders MUST wear hard hats, correctly fitting and to the latest BSI specifications according to the rules with the chin strap done up whilst mounted. All dressage hats must have a fitted chin strap.

Whilst not compulsory, we recommend that riders wear a body protector whilst jumping.

Any objections must be made, by the Team Manager, to the organiser within 5 minutes of the completion of the event, in writing on an official adjudication form, accompanied by a deposit of £30 which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.

The organisers shall not be liable for any claims in respect of damage or accident to any person, whether competitor, servant or spectator, horse, vehicle or property, howsoever caused in conjunction with or arising out of the show.

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Moreton EC officials and stewards

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the Championships
