

National Schools NSEA On-line Dressage Qualifiers 2021

Venue- at home! Date- 10th December – 10th January

1st & 2nd placed team & 1-4th placed individuals will qualify for the 24th annual

NSEA National Schools Championships 2021

Addington Manor, October 2021

3rd -8th placed team & 5th-8th placed individuals will qualify for the NSEA Championship Plate 2021 Keysoe 2021

Due to lockdown, the NSEA have decided to give riders the opportunity to qualify for the NSEA National Championships online.

DRESSAGE

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2020 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..

Class 1 Prelim = P 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 2 Novice = N 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 3 Elementary = E 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

Entry Fee £18 per test

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules)

The top 2 teams & 4 Individuals will qualify for the Championships

Dressage Tests may be ridden in any 20 x 40m arena on a surface or on grass. Tests may be called.

To video

Tests must be videoed from the 'C' end of the arena and must be completed in one session, as you would in any competition.

Stand back approx. 3m from C, as if you were in the position of the dressage judge.

Make sure that the whole horse is in the video at all times (Tests may be videoed from a phone or camera)

Download your video on to YouTube - include the riders first name only and the name of the horse in your code.

Check that the email link to your test works. (the link cannot be viewed if private, the video is not too dark, out of focus, filmed from the wrong end of the arena, upside down or the wrong test!)

The link must take you to your YouTube video, otherwise it will not be counted.

To enter

- 1. Enter & payment online only via the NSEA website Competition Dates Page. Other forms of entry will not be accepted.
- 2. So that your video can be viewed, email your name, horse, class number & Youtube code to office@nsea.co.uk by 10th January
- 3. Entries & video links <u>must arrive by the close of entries</u> date 10th January as stated below, otherwise they will not be included in the competition. Open to NSEA members only.
- 4. TEAM MANAGERS- please declare your teams by the entries closure date (10th January) via email to office@nsea.co.uk

You may only submit a video once per horse/rider combination per class.

We aim for results to be posted on the NSEA website two weeks after the competition closure date. Send a SAE if you wish to receive your dressage test sheet. Placings 1-6th at each competition. Entry Fee £18 per test.

SAE for rosettes/ prizes to: NSEA Pop-Up DR, PO Box 309, Mayfield, TN22 9FF (Rosettes to 6th will be sent out on receipt of a sae)

Please note..

Horses do not need to be plaited
Riders to look smart, but do not need to wear competition kit
Phones must record live noise- no mute buttons or music
Tests may be called but not coached
Whips are allowed
Tack- BD rules- snaffle bit, no martingales. Gloves should be worn
