Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2020)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies
