Classes 1 – 5 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

Class 1 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on style. Not timed

Class 2 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Single phase

Class 3 Grass Roots Mixed Height Teams 40, 50, 60, 70. (One rider per height.)

Class 4 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 5 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Classes 6-9 NSEA 30cm Rule applies

Class 6 70-75 cm RPL Teams & Individuals Open to all Single phase

Class 7 80-85cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 8 90-95cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules 2021-22 on the NSEA website. See below for eligibility in the height classes:

Grass Roots Rules for classes 1 - 5

GR1) Classes & Eligibility

40cm Grass Roots classes are judged on rider position and style only over a simple course of fences. Riders may be led or assisted. Classes may be split into a) led and b) assisted. This class is for genuine novice riders only. There will be an additional prize for the best rider under 6yrs on 1st Jan 2021.

ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 70cm class (or higher) on ANY pony at ANY competition (not just NSEA) is NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

50cm Grass Roots classes will be a single-phase competition. May be assisted but not led. There will be an award for the best rider under 7yrs on 1st Jan 2020. This class is for genuine novice riders only.

ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 80cm class (or higher) on ANY pony in ANY competition (not just NSEA) is immediately ineligible for Grass Roots 40 & 50 cm qualifiers & championship classes.

Also, ANY PONY / RIDER <u>COMBINATION</u> who have competed at 70cm in ANY competition (not just NSEA) are NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

60cm Grass Roots classes will be single phase competitions, no outside assistance. There will be an award for the best rider under 8yrs on 1st Jan 2020. Horse/ Rider <u>combinations</u> who have **completed** courses at 80cm (at ANY competition, not just NSEA competitions) may only compete h/c in 60cm classes, or they must ride a different pony.

70cm Grass Roots classes. Single phase, no outside assistance Riders jumping at this level are not eligible for 40cm Grass Roots on ANY pony.

75cm Grass Roots (Open). Individual class only. Single phase, no outside assistance. This is a progressive class to bridge the gap between Grass Roots & other NSEA classes. It is open to Grass Roots riders / combinations who are starting to jump 80cm classes.

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the "spirit" of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to "pot hunt," as it is not in the spirit of the competition. The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships.

Terms & Conditions

Due to limited parking, we ask that horses are not left unattended unless securely boxed and must not be tethered outside. Please park sensibly and close together.

PARWOOD HAS A NO SMOKING POLICY.

All dogs, if attending, must be kept on a lead on the showground at all times.

NO BICYCLES to be ridden on showground.

It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their rubbish. Please DO NOT skip out at the venue – take home any droppings made by your horse. All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over.

No entry will be refunded or transferred after the closing date except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate.

Parwood Equestrian Centre reserves the right to cancel any show, alter classes or refuse any entries without explanation. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made less £3.00 per entry to cover administration costs.

Please ensure the show ground is kept tidy

It is a condition of entry that no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers, Parwood, their representatives or helpers for any loss or damage to spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends or property under any circumstances whatsoever It is the responsibility of all competitors to present themselves in time for the classes in which they are entered.

Protective headgear, properly secured must be worn at all times when mounted. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SNZ3838 1998. All competitors must wear correct riding dress.

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition All enquiries are to be made by the Team Manager please.
