Important information - please read

Declaration Form.

Please fill out the attached form stating where your teams / individuals qualified for both EC & County classes by 14th May.

ALL <u>individually qualified</u> competitors must be the same horse / rider combination who qualified.

Teams- 2 horse rider combinations to be the same as at the time of qualifying for this event.

Passports- The last vaccination MUST be within 6 months of the 28th May and all other vaccinations must be within normal annual parameters. Random checks will occur at the competition.

Health Check- please take your horse's temperature before leaving home. Any horse with a raised temperature, cough, unusual nasal discharge, ringworm etc, please discuss with your vet before leaving home.

Start Times will be available on the NSEA website 2 days before the competition www.nsea.org.uk

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Horses must not be left tied to vehicles unattended. Take all litter home with you.

Leave stable mucked out. All hay & droppings must be removed. All stable bookings close 5 days before the show. Horses wishing to stable together MUST be booked together.

All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

The restaurant will be serving hot evening meals as well as food all day. There are showers in the stable area for those staying on site.

The **Team Manager** is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties (parents, supporters etc) at **all times** on the show ground.

Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must ask the stable manager where it may be pitched. No fires or camping gas cookers in the lorry park or stable field. Parents must remain on site at all times.

NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitors, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times- most of them are volunteers and give up their time for your sport.

Refunds- only with a vet cert / doctors note less £5 per entry admin fee. In the event of cancellation, you entry will be refunded on receipt of an email, less £5 per entry admin fee.

The NSEA will not be held responsible for any financial loss incurred by any entrant, their associates or attendees as a result of a re-arrangement to the schedule, postponement or cancellation of a competition.

Classes

In order to accommodate preferences, we will be running the 80 & 90 Eventers Challenge Championships over two days. It is all the same competition but schools can opt to compete on the first or second day, depending on what other classes they are competing in. This ensures that horses do not need to compete in too many classes in one day, or have too many gaps! You only enter once and state the preferred day on the Declaration Form which must be emailed to Mrs Whittington on the day of online entry.

All classes and jumping warm ups are on sand surfaces.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination.
