DRESSAGE

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2022 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..

Class 1 Prelim = P 7 (2002) Warm Up class

Class 2 Prelim = P 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 3 Novice = N 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 4 Elementary = E 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

Entry Fee £20 per test

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules')

The top 2 teams & 4 Individuals will qualify for the Championships

Please note that Dressage tests at the Championships will be:

Championship Individual Tests 2022 all ridden in **20x60m** arenas
Prelim 17A (2017), Novice 37A (2017) (Elementary 55 (2019),

Championship Team Tests 2022 all ridden in **20x40m** arenas
Team Tests = Prelim 14 (2006) revised collectives 2016 (up to two riders), Novice 34 (2009) (up to two riders)

Entry Fee £20 per test

- It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British standard EN1384 or PAS015 at ALL times while mounted on Martley Hall Stud* property.
 - Horses and Ponies **MUST NOT** be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended – please clear up any mess left by you or your horses
 - Horses and Ponies must be accompanied by their passport and must have Equine Flu vaccinations in date within 6mths. Spot checks may take place.
 - No smoking or drinking of alcohol in the arena or viewing area
 - All competitors/owners and their guests are required to adhere to commonly accepted standards of decency and good behaviour. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.

- No mucking out onto any indoor or outdoor areas. An immediate fine of £20 will apply if this is seen to take place.
- Litter is to be taken home with you or disposed of in the big bins provided. Please use recycling bins if provided.
- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.
- Please return any equipment used back to its storage area after use
- Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times. Dogs must be cleared up after.
