Class B Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class C Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class D 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class E 1.10m Advanced Open Horse Individual Qualifier Single phase.

Class F 1.10 Advanced Open Pony Individual Qualifier. Single phase.
