Arena 2: NSEA Grass Roots Qualifiers

Class 1 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted)

Judged on style only. There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 6yrs on 1st Jan 2022.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 2 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted)

Single Phase: There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 7yrs on 1st Jan 2022.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 3 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (un-assisted)

Single Phase: There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by a rider under 8yrs on 1st Jan 2022.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 4 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted)

Single Phase: There will be an additional prize for the best horsemanship displayed by any rider.

Entry Fee: £20 per combination

Class 5 Introductory 75cm Individual Only (un-assisted)

Single Phase: An additional prize will be awarded for the best horsemanship displayed by any rider.

Class 6 Mini 70-75 cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single Phase: Open to all

Entry Fee: £22 per combination

Class 7 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single Phase: Open to all

Entry Fee: £22 per combination

Class 8 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single Phase

Entry fee: £22 per combination

Class 9 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier *including Hickstead Elite 1m Team Qualifier*

Single Phase. Top two teams will also qualify for Hickstead 2021.

Entry fee: £22 per combination

Class 10a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier & Team Competition *including Hickstead Elite 1.10 Individual Qualifier*

Single phase. This class will be jumped in 2 sections 9a) Horses, 9b) Ponies, but will be scored as one competition

Top two horses & two ponies will qualify to compete at Hickstead

Entry fee: £22 per combination

Entry Fees to include paramedic first aid cover, NSEA levy and VAT

A one-off booking fee of £1.50 will be charged at the time of booking.

NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules 2021-22 on the NSEA website. See below for eligibility in the height classes:

Grass Roots Rules for classes 1 - 5

GR1) Classes & Eligibility

40cm Grass Roots classes are judged on rider position and style only over a simple course of fences. Riders may be led or assisted. Classes may be split into a) led and b) assisted. This class is for genuine novice riders only. ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 70cm class (or higher) on ANY pony at ANY competition (not just NSEA) is NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

50cm Grass Roots classes will be a single-phase competition. May be assisted but not led. This class is for genuine novice riders only. ANY RIDER who has competed in ANY 80cm class (or higher) on ANY pony in ANY competition (not just NSEA) is immediately ineligible for Grass Roots 40 & 50 cm qualifiers & championship classes. Also, ANY PONY / RIDER COMBINATION who have competed at 70cm in ANY competition (not just NSEA) are NOT eligible for this class, (except h/c if space permits)

60cm Grass Roots classes will be single phase competitions, no outside assistance. Horse/ Rider combinations who have **completed** courses at 80cm (at ANY competition, not just NSEA competitions) may only compete h/c in 60cm classes, or they must ride a different pony.

70cm Grass Roots classes. Single phase, no outside assistance Riders jumping at this level are not eligible for 40cm Grass Roots on ANY pony.

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the “spirit” of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to “pot hunt,” as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships.

Rosettes will be awarded to the top 6 teams & the top 8 individuals in both the Grass Roots and RPL classes
