Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2020)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Open 1m-1.05m Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5a/b Advanced 1.10m Open Individual Qualifier

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

Entry Fee: £20 per rider per round

(Entry fee £15 including VAT + Paramedic First Aid Cover £3 + NSEA Levy £2)

Entries Close: 12 noon Monday 14th March, or earlier if classes are full.

All TEAM MANAGERS must declare teams NO LATER than 12 noon on Monday 14th March.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY CHANGES AFTER MIDDAY ON FRIDAY 18th MARCH.

No entries will be accepted on day of competition.

Late entries may be accepted if space permits but will incur a £3 surcharge.

Any alterations to entries will incur a £6 admin fee.

Withdrawals made prior to closing date will receive a refund of the entry fee with a £6 admin fee deducted.

No refunds will be given after close of entries.

In the event of cancellation due to weather, a minimum of 50% of your entry fee will be refunded.
