




National Schools NSEA Show Jumping Qualifier

Classes:-

Warm up 60cm Clear Round. A clear round rosette will be given to all clear rounds in this class. £12 per competitor

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier £16 (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2020) Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier £16 Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. £16 Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier £16 Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5 1.10m Advanced Horse Open Individual Qualifier Single phase.

Class 6 110cm Advanced Pony Open Individual Qualifier
