## NSEA JwS Qualifiers

Start times will be available on the NSEA website two days before the competition  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed team and 1<sup>st</sup>- 4<sup>th</sup> placed individuals will qualify for the Annual NSEA National Schools  
Championships 2022  
3<sup>rd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> placed team and 5<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> placed individuals will qualify for the  
NSEA Championship Plate 2022.

**CLASS 1 Mini 70-75cm Team and Individual Qualifier**

Riders to be aged under 14 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022  
All team riders automatically count as individuals

**CLASS 2 Novice 80-85cm Team and Individual Qualifier**

All team riders automatically count as individuals

**CLASS 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team and Individual Qualifier**

All team riders automatically count as individuals

**CLASS 4 Open 1-1.05m Team and Individual Qualifier**

All team riders automatically count as individuals

**CLASS 5 Advanced 1.10m Individual qualifier a) horses and b) ponies**

Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony as this class will be split.

**Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> for individuals Classes 1-5, and 1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> Class 6 and 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> for teams.**

## NSEA Dressage Qualifiers

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores count. Up to two riders to compete in the Prelim test and up to two riders in the Novice test. All team riders automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional Rules')

The top 2 teams and 4 individuals will qualify for the Championships.

Open to all. Non-Qualifier

**CLASS 8 Prelim =P13 (2006) Team and Individual Qualifier**

**CLASS 9 Novice =N28 (2008) Team and Individual Qualifier**

**CLASS 10 Elementary = E50 (2007) Individual Qualifier only**

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**£ 18 per entry to include Medical Cover, NSEA Levy**

**Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> for individuals Classes 7-10, and 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> for teams Classes 8 and 9.**
