Rules – NSEA General Rules plus 'Additional Rules for Qualifiers 2021/22

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2022) All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier a) horses and b) ponies Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony section of the class, as the class will be split.

NUMBER BIBS ESSENTIAL - PRINT YOUR OWN NUMBERS

Clothing – XC colours, body protectors, number bibs, skull caps (no peaked hats), beige or white jods. Plaiting not required.

• you are strongly advised to acquaint yourselves with the terms of the NSEA insurance cover which is provided to all registered riders and the team manager of member schools; and we will not be liable for any acts or omissions of our employees, agents and sub-contractors in relation to any activity at NSEA events or for any loss or damage suffered by you as a result of taking part in any activity at NSEA events.

• It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British standard EN1384 or PAS015 at ALL times while mounted on Boyton Hall property.

• It is mandatory for all riders to wear Body Protecters British standard EN13158/2009 BETA Level 3 at ALL times while mounted on Boyton Hall property.

• Horses and Ponies MUST NOT be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended – please clear up any mess left by you or your horses

• Horses and Ponies must be accompanied by their passport and must have Equine Flu vaccinations in date within 6mths. Spot checks may take place.

• No smoking or drinking of alcohol in the arena or viewing area

• All competitors/owners and their guests are required to adhere to commonly accepted standards of decency and good behaviour. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.

•No mucking out onto any indoor or outdoor areas. An immediate fine of £20 will apply if this is seen to take place.

•Litter is to be taken home with you or disposed of in the big bins provided. Please use recycling bins if provided.

•Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

•Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times. Dogs must be cleared up after.

•No access to the stableyard or any of the other private area

•Arrive and leave at the same entry – DO NOT DRIVE DOWN THROUGH THE STABLE YARD •Do not allow horses/ponies to touch any arena mirrors.

•No more than 8 riders in the warm up arena at anytime.

•PLEASE PRINT YOUR NUMBERS and wear your OWN NUMBER BIBS

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition
