Entries Close: Monday 20th June 2022 or when classes full – entries will be on a first-come basis and a wait list will be held.

Clear round – will run for an hour in the arena before the start of the classes - £5 per round. Entries will be limited and will be on a first come first serve basis. Qualified combinations only.

Class 1 GR 40cm Team & Individual Championship (may be led/assisted). Maximum Time.

Class 2 GR 50cm Team & Individual Championship (may be assisted)

Optimum time.

Class 3 GR 60cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted). Single Phase.

Class 4 Introductory 70cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted)

Class 5 Mixed Teams - max of two riders can ride at the same height.

All classes are open to eligible competitors only. Please note if any of your team members have also qualified as individuals in any given class.

Classes 2-4 will also have a style prize awarded to the rider with the best style round.

Entry Fee - £19 per class (includes Paramedics). Late entries £3 extra if space permits. Cheques payable to "Moreton Equestrian Ltd" or email enquiries@moretondorset.co.uk for Bacs details.

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count.

Prizes: Individual rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place in each class. Team rosettes $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ in each class.

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Take all litter home with you. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

Outside assistance will not be tolerated- and could result in elimination. NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground

All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times. Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable.
